The Quilt Museum and Gallery opened in 2008 and cares for a unique collection of over 800 quilts and related artifacts collected from around the British Isles dating from the earliest piece in the collection, the 1718 Silk Patchwork Coverlet, to the present day.

The Quilt Museum and Gallery is independently funded through admissions, grants and donations and is managed by The Quilters' Guild of the British Isles, an educational charity formed in 1979 to promote the allied crafts of patchwork, applique and quilting. The Museum and Gallery is run by a small team of staff and dedicated volunteers.

Based in St Anthony's Hall, a magnificent timber framed medieval guildhall in York city centre. The Quilt Museum and Gallery exhibits pieces from The Quilters' Guild Collection and work by contemporary makers. The Museum and Gallery also loans pieces to other museums and galleries in the UK and exhibits at the Festival of Quilts at the NEC in Birmingham each August.
