

## Requirements List

### Sweetie Paper Evening Bags with Ann Holden

Create stunning and unique evening bags to match your outfit using layers of sheer fabric, sweetie papers, and machining using decorative automatic or utility stitches. In the spirit of wartime 'make do and mend', this is an inventive way to recycle what would normally be thrown away, and to make something creative and beautiful from it. No-one will guess that the subtle shimmer peeking through the fabric comes courtesy of Cadbury's or Kit Kat!

#### Requirements

1m Iron-on Vilene\*

1m Pelmet Vilene\*

1m lining fabric such as polyester satin\*

Foil sweet papers such as Roses or Kit Kat (not the type with cellophane)

Net in a metallic colour such as silver, gold or copper \*

1m each of 2 colours of sheer fabric to match your colour scheme\*

Selection of machine embroidery threads in your colour scheme including metallic and variegated

Optional – beads, glitter, sequins, gold or silver flakes

\*I will bring these items on the day for you to purchase if you wish. To ensure that I bring adequate supplies please let me know when booking if you would like me to bring anything.

In addition you will need some type of binding, cord and fastening. I find it is better to choose these once the bag is constructed, but bring what you have and try it out. Alternatively you could pop out at lunchtime to the shops in York. (Duttons for Buttons has a good range).
